Rules of Greyhound Racing of Greyhound Racing SA Limited

From 1:57pm, 30th April 2021, the following restrictions apply to all persons attending South Australia, from interstate and overseas, for greyhound racing:

NON-RESTRICTED LOCATIONS

- (1) There are no restrictions to nominations from any person usually resident in:
- (a) Australian Capital Territory;
 - (b) New South Wales;
 - (c) Northern Territory;
 - (d) Queensland;
 - (e) Tasmania;
 - (f) Victoria;
 - (g) Western Australia; and,
 - (h) New Zealand,

provided that,

- (2) At, or after, nomination, *if requested*, that person provides a copy of their *current* SA Police cross-border permit approval (including the ET##### number and expiry date). (All interstate persons must register their travel into South Australia with SA Police).

RESTRICTED LOCATIONS

(1) Nominations will be not accepted from any person usually resident in (or travelling from):

(a) **Overseas (other than New Zealand),**

except:

- (i) If the nominating person receives written approval from the Controlling Body for racing in South Australia, upon written application to the Controlling Body no later than 2-clear days before the proposed entry into South Australia;
- (ii) That person provides a copy of their *current* SA Police cross-border permit approval (including the ET##### number and expiry date), with their application under (1)(a), to the Controlling Body for racing in South Australia. (All interstate persons must register their travel into South Australia with SA Police); and,
- (iii) At, or after, approval from the Controlling Body, *if requested*, that person provides evidence that they satisfied their obligations under the *Emergency Management (Cross Border Travel) (COVID-19) Directions 2021*, that are in force at the time applicable to them.

Example – If that person is required, under the relevant Directions, to follow a requirement under a restriction level(), they must, if requested, provide evidence that they satisfied that requirement.*

BEFORE YOU TRAVEL INTO OR RETURN TO SOUTH AUSTRALIA

During times of a COVID-19 cluster outbreak, anywhere in Australia, the SA Government will amend the Emergency Management (Cross Border Travel) (COVID-19) Directions 2021 to restrict cross-border movement. *This will affect you if you travel across (to or from) the SA state border.*

Before you travel to South Australia, check for any restrictions, and register for your cross-border travel at:

TO APPLY, YOU WILL NEED:

- Your full name
- Your date of birth
- Your residential address
- The names of *everyone* accompanying you (*you need to complete an application for each person – either you can, or they can*)
- Your mobile number
- Your email address
- The date you intend to travel across the border into SA
- The location of your accommodation (*if your trip is the same day, put in the relevant greyhound racing track you are attending*)
- The date you intend to return (can be same day)

Note: you need to apply separately for each person accompanying you – so, you need the above information for every one of them

You will receive an email with your permit details (ET#####) – please keep that ready for production at the border.

NOTE: EVEN SOUTH AUSTRALIA RESIDENTS NEED TO APPLY FOR A PERMIT TO RETURN TO SOUTH AUSTRALIA AFTER CROSSING THE BORDER.

NOTE ALSO: YOU MAY NEED TO APPLY FOR A PERMIT TO RETURN TO YOUR HOME STATE – SEE LINKS BELOW FOR YOUR STATE'S REQUIREMENTS.

Also note:

- Check the [Greyhound Racing SA site](https://www.greyhoundracing.com.au/south-australia) for any notices about restrictions relating to greyhound movement (e.g., animal quarantine).
- You must still nominate for racing and trialling using the usual method.

BEFORE YOU LEAVE SOUTH AUSTRALIA

Before you travel from South Australia into another state or territory (*including if you are returning home*), check for any restrictions, and register for cross-border travel (if needed) at:

Even though you may be returning to your home state, you may still need a permit from your home state. This includes South Australia.
