### *Restrictions on Interstate/Overseas Nominations*

From 12:01am, 18 February 2021, the following restrictions apply to all persons attending South Australia, from interstate, for greyhound racing:

#### VICTORIA

- (1) The “*affected areas of Victoria*” means:
- (a) A “*prohibited location*” that means and includes the *Greater Melbourne* local government areas:
- (i) Banyule;
  - (ii) Hume;
  - (iii) Moreland;
  - (iv) Bayside;
  - (v) Kingston;
  - (vi) Mornington Peninsula;
  - (vii) Boroondara;
  - (viii) Knox;
  - (ix) Nillumbik;
  - (x) Brimbank;
  - (xi) Manningham;
  - (xii) Port Phillip;
  - (xiii) Cardinia;
  - (xiv) Maribyrnong;
  - (xv) Stonnington;
  - (xvi) Casey;
  - (xvii) Maroondah;
  - (xviii) Whitehorse;
  - (xix) Darebin;
  - (xx) Melbourne;
  - (xxi) Whittlesea;
  - (xxii) Frankston;
  - (xxiii) Melton;
  - (xxiv) Wyndham;

- (xxvii) Yarra;
  - (xxviii) Greater Dandenong;
  - (xxix) Moonee Valley;
  - (xxx) Yarra Ranges;
  - (xxxi) Hobsons Bay; and,
  - (xxxii) the Shire of Mitchell.
- (2) Nominations will not be accepted from any person who is usually resident within, or who has been (for any reason) from 12:01am, 4 February 2021 at, the *affected areas of Victoria*.
- (3) Nominations will be accepted from any person who is *not* usually resident, or who has *not* been (for any reason), in the affected areas of Victoria, *provided*:
- (a) At, or after, nomination, *if requested*, that person provides a copy of their *current* SA Police cross-border permit approval (including the ET##### number and expiry date). (All interstate persons must register their travel into South Australia with SA Police); and,
  - (b) At, or after, nomination, *if requested*, that person provides evidence that they satisfied their obligations under the Emergency Management (Cross Border Travel) (COVID-19) Direction 2021, that is in force at the time applicable to their nomination.
- Example – if that person is required, under the relevant Direction, to submit to a COVID-19 test, they must, if requested, provide evidence of that test and the result.*

## REMAINDER STATES

- (1) There are no restrictions to nominations from any person usually resident in:
- (a) The Australian Capital Territory;
  - (b) New South Wales
  - (c) The Northern Territory;
  - (d) Queensland;
  - (e) Tasmania; and,
  - (f) Western Australia,
- provided that,*
- (2) At, or after, nomination, *if requested*, that person provides a copy of their *current* SA Police cross-border permit approval (including the ET##### number and expiry date). (All interstate persons must register their travel into South Australia with SA Police).

## NEW ZEALAND

- (1) Nominations will be accepted from any person from New Zealand, *except*:
- (a) If that person has been present within (for any length of time), New Zealand in the preceding 14-days to their arrival in SA;
- And provided that,*
- (b) At, or after, nomination, *if requested*, that person provides a copy of their *current* SA Police cross-border permit approval (including the ET##### number and expiry date). (All interstate persons must register their travel into South Australia with SA Police); and,

- (c) At, or after, nomination, *if requested*, that person provides evidence that they satisfied their obligations under the *Emergency Management (Cross Border Travel) (COVID-19) Direction 2021*, that is in force at the time applicable to them.

*Example – if that person is required, under the relevant Direction, to submit to a COVID-19 test, they must, if requested, provide evidence of that test and the result,*

and,

- (d) Where applicable, that person has followed the Stewards' Notice for [quarantine restrictions](#) on New Zealand kennel cough.

## BEFORE YOU TRAVEL INTO SOUTH AUSTRALIA

During times of a COVID-19 cluster outbreak, anywhere in Australia, the SA Government will amend the *Emergency Management (Cross Border Travel) (COVID-19) Direction 2021* to restrict cross-border movement. *This will affect you if you travel across (to or from) the SA state border.*

**Before you travel to South Australia, check for any restrictions, and register for your cross-border travel at:**

[CrossBorderTravel \(police.sa.gov.au\)](https://police.sa.gov.au/CrossBorderTravel)

### TO APPLY, YOU WILL NEED:

- Your full name
- Your date of birth
- Your residential address
- The names of *everyone* accompanying you (*you need to complete an application for each person – either you can, or they can*)
- Your mobile number
- Your email address
- The date you intend to travel across the border into SA
- The location of your accommodation (*if your trip is the same day, put in the relevant greyhound racing track you are attending*)
- The date you intend to return (can be same day)

*Note: you need to apply separately for each person accompanying you – so, you need the above information for every one of them*

You will receive an email with your permit details (ET#####) – please keep that ready for production at the border.

**NOTE ALSO: YOU MAY NEED TO APPLY FOR A PERMIT TO RETURN TO YOUR HOME STATE – SEE LINKS BELOW FOR YOUR STATE’S REQUIREMENTS.**

Also note:

- Check the [Greyhound Racing SA site](#) for any notices about restrictions relating to greyhound movement (e.g., animal quarantine).
- You must still nominate for racing and trialling using the usual method.

## **BEFORE YOU LEAVE SOUTH AUSTRALIA**

Before you travel from South Australia into another state or territory (including if you are returning home), check for any restrictions, and register for cross-border travel (if needed) at:
